Enzo Boglietti Dolcettos d'Alba

Enzo Boglietti is the project of two brothers best known for the outstanding Barolos they produce in the town of La Morra. With about 50 acres of vines (some over 100 years old) planted along Piedmont's famed "golden slope" it's hard to say anything these brothers produce is second tier. While the name Dolcetto translates to "little sweet one," this is a quite dry and very serious food wine. The wine leads with tart cherry fruit that dances over an earthy and savory palate loaded with ripe tannins. Classic pairings for Dolcetto are anything with a red sauce, but there's a ripe core to this wine that will go great with grilled meats for any sneaky late season barbecues.
