Moillard Beaujolais-Villages

Moillard is a "Villages" level wine, which means it's a bit bolder and more serious than a young, fresh nouveau. The region's Gamay grape in general is wonderfully versatile with food, it's lean but not wimpy, and fruit driven while still having an intriguing backbone of black pepper and baking spice. Moillard is a traditional style for the region, starting fermentation with whole clusters of grapes and letting them press under their own weight for a few days before crushing. It's an old school wine from an old school producer, but stylistically this wine falls right in line with the bright and zippy reds that wine drinkers have been flocking toward in recent years.
